Sapelo dates back about 4,500 years. North Carolina tobacco heir Richard J. Reynolds, Jr. (1906-1964). Reynolds utilized the island as a part-time residence for thirty years. Sapelo Island is a state-protected barrier island located in McIntosh County, Georgia. The island is accessible only by aircraft or boat.

WOW I have not been to Sapelo in over 20 years. I do know they did not get electricity till 1963 and phone service 10 years latter. So if you want to step back in time this is the place to do it.

If you see cars on the island look at the tag. They never register the cars with the state. I asked about insurance? My guide said don't need it. I had to ask, what if you get in an accident? Guides said you bang out the dent tell you friend you sorry and go home!
