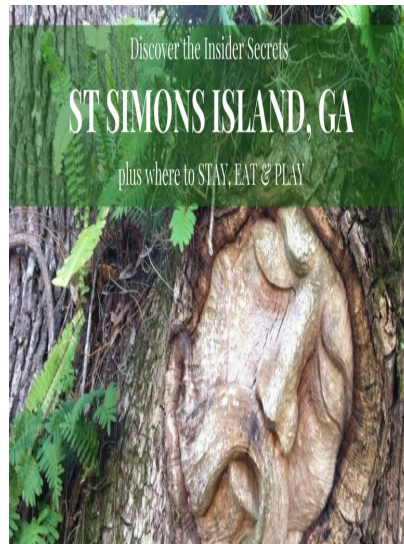

We will leave the Ramada at 8 AM. About 9:30 AM arrive on St. Simons Island. Take some time to stretch and use the facilities before we meet our guide for a trip back in time.

Our guide will narrate delightful stories from Prehistoric geologic beginnings of these barrier islands, through the Colonial Era, the Plantation Era, the Civil War, the Timber Era, up to the elegant present day Resort Era. Hear about the Spanish missionaries who made their effort at Christianizing the Guale Indians during the 15th & 16th centuries, only to be driven away by the repeated uprisings. We will tour the remains of the Frederica Village, where five different languages were spoken. Hear stories about the colorful inhabitants, including John & Charles Wesley, the founders of Methodism. At Historic Christ Church hear about the "Beloved Invader" and the church's reconstruction during the Timber Era.

After the tour have lunch on your own as there are many restaurant choices. Enjoy unique shops, many with a tropical theme. There is a very delicious ice cream shop, I happen to know personally. Just a few steps away is a pier overlooking the St. Simon Sound, looking out onto the Atlantic. You may want to walk out on the pier or sit in one of the chairs at the water's edge to take in some natural beauty, There are 3 Spirit trees in the area that you can have fun finding.
